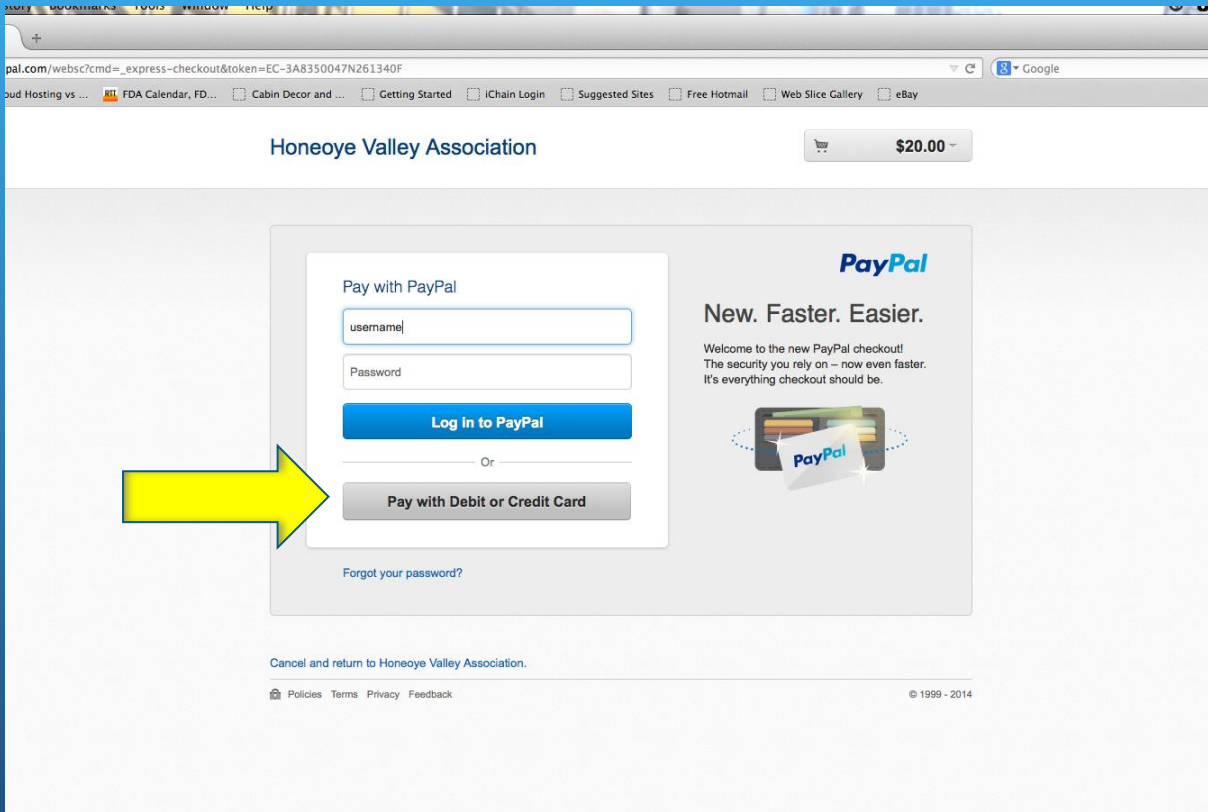

Another recent example of the efforts of the HVA...

*Parts 59 and 190 of Title 6 NY Codes, Rules and Regulations (6NYCRR);
Proposed Amendments Prohibiting the Launching or Retrieval of Watercraft
from a DEC -Operated Boat Launch Unless the Watercraft is Free From any
Plant or Animal or Parts Thereof*

The HVA wrote letters to NYS officials on behalf of the HVA membership in support of the amendments above during the brief review period.

The HVA also raised awareness of the legislation to the Richmond Town Board and provided a draft letter of support which was accepted, signed and submitted by the Town Board.
