Honeoye Lake Watershed Task Force November 2017 Update

- 1. Water Quality Update
 - a. The summer of 2017 was very typical of the summers over the last 10 years in terms of water quality as measured by water clarity, amount of algae (Chl-a) in the water column, and Total Phosphorus.
- 2. NYS DEC Honeoye Lake Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) analysis project
 - DEC has completed and approved the Honeoye Lake TMDL report.
 - b. Now the Governor's office must review and approve our TMDL report.
 - c. Once it is approved by the Governor's office, our TMDL report will be released for a 30-day public review and comment period. Time TBD.
 - DEC plans to schedule a public information meeting to review their findings and recommendations.
- 3. Climate change on shallow NYS lakes research grant project (Cornell/FLCC)
 - a. Analyzing the water quality data collected last summer.
- 4. Finger Lakes Institute (FLI) Nitrogen & Fluoroprobe Research Studies
 - a. Plans to run lab tests and analyze all the weekly nitrogen samples collected last summer over the winter.
- 5. Inlet Restoration Project
 - Enhancements for the inlet restoration project have been completed.
 - b. More ditch plugs, vernal pools, and enhanced berms....
